Dear Bethel Families:

As of 4:45pm on 3/18/20, we were granted the waiver to reopen and provide care for our families. We will be here for your childcare needs. If you have a school aged child that will need care, please contact the office to work on arrangements. We will have a teacher here to watch them!

If you are off and are choosing to keep your child at home, please write an email or call the office to let us know of your plans. As long as, we are open and running, tuition is still expected for the week. If you are choosing to keep your child home and would like to use credit days to help with tuition that option is still available.

If it is decided that closures will continue beyond the 14-day period for schools and businesses, we will reevaluate and assess how we will move forward with operations at our center. We will work closely on an individualized basis to help support each family's unique situation.

We will continue to follow the changes we made on how entering the building will be handled. We will open the door and you will be greeted by the Director, Assistant Director, or staff member. We will request that any person entering our building wash their hands. We will be checking all temperatures upon entry and any child running 100 degrees Fahrenheit or above will be excused for 48 hours and cannot return without a doctor's note. Please give yourself extra time to get to work as it may take a few minutes for us to get to every family.

As a reminder, if you are showing any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, or shortness of breath you will be asked to have a doctor's note clearing you to return to Bethel.

We will keep you as up to date as possible on any other changes that may occur affecting our normal operational hours. Please keep an eye on our Facebook page for immediate updates, as well as email and our website. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our families safe!
